## Mark 10:28-31

  - A. What His Apostles Will Receive (Matt. 19:28)
    - Matt. 19:28 - And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
    - Cf. Luke 22:30 - that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

## Not Just for the Twelve!

- Although only the apostles are said to judge or rule over the 12 tribes of Israel, there is a sense in which the same role will true for all believers.
  - 1 Cor. 6:2 - Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent to *constitute* the smallest law courts?
  - Cf. Rev. 2:26-27; 20:4
