- 2) The elders should never settle disagreements between believers.
- 3) We should never identify and confront false teaching and false teachers.
- 4) We should never confront the sins of others.

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B. Respond to the Sin of Other Believers with Humility (3-5)

- 1) How Pride Responds to the Sins of Others (3-4)
 - a) Quick to notice the sins of others and to be blind to our own (3)
 - b) Quick to correct the sins of others and to tolerate our own (4)
- 2) How Humility Responds to the Sins of Others (5)
 - a) Accepts Jesus' diagnosis of hypocrisy (5a).
 - b) Takes the log out of one's own eye first (5b).
 - c) Helps a brother with his sin (5c).
