Three Views of Rom. 2:7-10...

- 1) Offering <u>salvation by works</u> to all unbelievers. [This view contradicts Scripture!]
- 2) Referring to God's reward of the obedience of those <u>already saved by grace through faith</u>.
- 3) Laying out the impossible condition for salvation by works apart from Christ.
