I. The Required OT Sacrifices

A. Two Sacrifices for Sin

- The Sin Offering (Lev. 4:1—5:13)
- The Guilt Offering (Lev. 5:14—6:7)

B. Two Categories of Sin

- Sins of commission — doing what God forbids (4:1-35; 5:17)
- Sins of omission — failing to do what God commands (5:1-13, 15-16)

C. Two Kinds of Guilt

- Sins committed ignorantly or negligently (4:2; 5:17-19)
- Sins committed deliberately (5:1; 6:2-3)
