2. God's Amazing Choice to Save Only a Remnant of Israel (27-29)!

a. God's decision is biblically clear (27).

- A remnant in the 1st century—and throughout the church age—who believe in their Messiah and His gospel (11:2-5, 7).
- A remnant in the future who will believe in their Messiah and His gospel (11:25-29).
 - During the Tribulation – 144,000 (Rev. 7:1-8)
 - At the 2nd Coming – “all Israel” (Rom. 11:26-27)

2. God's Amazing Choice to Save Only a Remnant of Israel (27-29)!
 - a. God's decision is biblically clear (27).
 - b. God's decision is unchangeably certain (28).
 - c. God's decision is perfectly just & gracious (29).
